WHAT IS MATH MASTERS?

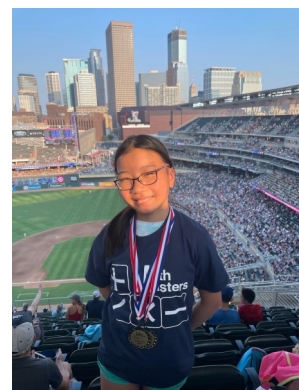
The Math Masters mathematics competition program challenges 4th, 5th and 6th grade students to use critical thinking and problem-solving skills in mathematics. Students compete as individuals and on teams in 6—8 rounds of competition, with their academic effort and achievement recognized with plaques, medallions and ribbons.

In 2022, Math Masters is planning more than 50 in-person competitions throughout Minnesota and western Wisconsin. The competitions, scheduled for February, March and April 2022, are expected to welcome between 5,000 and 6,000 students.

We are excited to offer 4th grade competitions for the first time in 2022!

How Does Math Masters Work?

- ◆ Teachers, coaches and parents select a competition and register their students. Register as many teams and students as you like—all are welcome!
- ◆ Watch for your coach's competition packet that contains selection tests, practice tests and competition details.
- ◆ Start practicing! You can practice before, during or after school—whatever works best for you!
- ◆ On competition day, students gather to compete, have fun and make new friends. Competitions last several hours and include a short break with snacks. Everyone gets a t-shirt!
- ◆ Competition format: 4th graders participate as individuals in two Individual rounds and a Tiebreaker round. 5th and 6th graders participate individually in a Fact Drill round, three Individual rounds and a Tiebreaker round. Most students register as part of a team and also compete in three Team rounds.
- ◆ Winners in each competition category (Fact Drill, Individual and Team) receive awards, including plaques, medallions and ribbons. Everyone receives a participation certificate.
- ◆ Top finishers in each grade are invited to a Twins game to celebrate their achievement.

Competition Test Topics

Eight rounds of problems (six rounds for 4th grade) cover the following mathematical areas:

- ◆ Number Facts / Order of Operations
- ◆ Numeracy / Properties of Numbers
- ◆ Geometry / Time / Money
- ◆ Statistics / Probability / Counting
- ◆ Decimals / Fractions / Percents

Coach Packet Contents

After payment is received, each coach receives a packet of helpful information and important competition details, including:

- ◆ Competition test and answers from the previous year
- ◆ Team selection tests
- ◆ Suggested team selection plan
- ◆ Site confirmation and competition schedule
- ◆ Competition procedures
