What is Math Masters?



The Math Masters mathematics competition program challenges 4th, 5th and 6th grade students to use critical thinking and problem-solving skills in a fun competition setting. Students compete as individuals and on teams to solve math problems, receiving recognition for their academic achievements.

Our annual competitions typically engage thousands of students throughout Minnesota and surrounding states. Students compete by grade level in area competitions in March and April. In 2023, Math Masters welcomed 4,640 students to 55 competition sites. Sixty—two 2024 competition sites are now open for registration.

Teachers Lewis Aase and Julia Espe co-founded Math Masters in 1989 to augment math education beyond the classroom. That year, the first Math Masters event in Austin, MN hosted 150 students. Since that time, more than 125,000 students have competed in Math Masters.
